### Threat of Destitution and Homelessness

The Australian Churches Refugee Taskforce is asking us to take urgent action advocating against the Federal Government's plan, expected to start in June, to remove basic financial support over the next 12 months from up to 12,000 people who are lawfully going through a refugee protection process. Any removal of financial supports will result in destitution and homelessness for many of the people. We are asked to contact the Prime Minister and Members of Parliament expressing our concern about this matter.
