- **[C] = Communion.** * Daniel is not authorised to administer communion. Each Church Council to decide whether to either: cancel for their 3rd Sunday; or to explore any alternative in conjunction with ministry team.
- **# = Supply Preacher.** Ministry Team will organise an alternate preacher (availability dependent; lay or clergy).
- Our Preaching Plan is a *living* document and is therefore subject to being changed upon short notice.
- Participation: For *Together* Worship, our ministers may choose three people from the cluster churches' rosters, for scripture readings / prayers of the people, so each of the churches has a representative leading worship. If rostered people do not hear from a minister (*or from the Ministers' Assistant at BNN*) for a *Together* worship, it could be they might be invited next time they're rostered for a *Together* worship.
- Daniel Farnsworth (ministry student) will be participating in various aspects of ministry across our cluster until possibly November. Daniel has also agreed to be engaged for 'Supply' preaching at regular worship.
- Presbytery reiterated that finding new ministers; long-term supply; short-term supply; and or ad-hoc supply; remains difficult, so we anticipate any unexpected new circumstances may result in further changes to this plan; and or adoption of technological solutions to continue delivering worship elements to our members.
- News / Notices Editors: It is recommended that no more than a couple of weeks advance notice of expected worship / preaching info be published, in light of likely future changes per above. It's suggested that only key people who have to prepare rosters and or plan ahead for worship be provided with a full copy of this plan.
